

C.W. WISDOM SCHOLARSHIP

GUIDELINES

1. ONE scholarship of \$1250 will be given to the selectee.
2. Applicants must be a graduate of Alva High School and demonstrate the desire to study for the medical doctor degree.
3. Scholarship applications are due in superintendent's (counselor's) office by March 22. It must contain the signature of the applicant and the signature of one parent or guardian.
4. Presentation of the scholarship award shall be made during the end-of-school awards assembly and appropriate publicity shall be released at that time.
5. Scholarship applicants shall not know who the selectee is prior to the formal presentation.
6. Selectee will be chosen based on:
 - a) Financial need
 - b) Aptitude
 - c) Scholastic Achievement
 - d) Personal interview by the committee
7. Selectee will be paid \$125 per month for 10 months beginning on August 1, if the selectee has proof of enrollment in the proper program of study.
8. If the selectee withdraws, drops out of school or fails to remain in the program of study at any time during the year of the award, the monthly payments will cease.
