

Staff Conflict of Interest

Ensuring that the district is staffed by the individuals best suited for each position is of the utmost importance. At the same time, it is important that conflicts of interest do not exist between administrators and those they supervise.

Therefore, the District will not hire, or assign, individuals such that any employee is related, within the third degree of consanguinity or affinity, to an administrator who has direct supervisory responsibility for that employee.

The third degree of consanguinity or affinity is defined by the State Attorney General's opinion, shown in the following Exhibit.

Administrative positions in the District are the following:

- Superintendent and Assistant Superintendent
- Principal and Assistant Principal
- Child Nutrition Supervisor
- Coordinator of Cooperative Education Project
- Transportation Director
