

Extended School Year Program

In recognition that some students with a disability need special education and related services in excess of the 180 days provided during the traditional school year, the Alva Independent School District #001 has developed this extended school year program. This program and its attendant procedures do not supersede or preempt the prerogative of the individualized education planning team. The intent is to assure thorough review and careful consideration of the needs of the small number of our student population who need additional special help.

Extended School Year

For the purpose of this program, extended school year shall mean special education and related services in excess of 180 days per school year at no cost to participants.

Purpose

The purpose of this program is to serve those students who suffer from regression outside the regular school year to such a marked degree that they will not be able to recoup the loss within a reasonable period of time at the commencement of the school year. The thrust of this program will be to limit regression during the summer so as to enable recoupment within a reasonable period of time when school resumes. The services which a student will require in order to avoid regression that cannot be recouped within a reasonable time will be determined on an individual basis.

The superintendent is directed to establish regulations setting forth eligibility standards for this program.
