

Board Policy for Education of "Gifted Children"

The Board believes that "Gifted Children" require assistance for development of extraordinary learning abilities and should be provided with adequate programs to meet their special needs.

Instruction of the identified gifted student will include enrichment of content, acceleration of content, individualization of instruction, a modified, open-ended curriculum, guided research or any combination of the above. This instruction will be carried out within the classroom with a minimum of pull-out activities as directed by the gifted teacher. The teacher will write a plan for each student who qualifies for the gifted program. The primary areas to be stressed will be math, science, language arts, social studies and computer science.

The superintendent will be responsible for developing rules and procedures to implement these programs.
