

Interrogations of Students

In the event it is necessary for properly identified officials of agencies who have a right of access to students to interrogate or interview students at school during school hours, the school shall cooperate on the following basis:

- I. Interrogation: (Law Enforcement Officials)
 - A. It is the responsibility of the law enforcement officer to notify the parent or legal custodian prior to an interrogation. Whether or not the interrogation shall proceed in the absence of the parent/legal custodian is to be determined by the law enforcement officer.

- II. Interview: (Law Enforcement Officials, Department of Human Services Personnel and Court Related Community Service Officials)
 - A. The agency official may notify the parent/legal custodian prior to an interview; however, it should be recognized that sometimes circumstances preclude notification prior to the interview or would impede the investigation.
