There are many organizations giving "honors" to students for achievements in activities or academics. Many of these "honors" are empty and are only ways for the company to make a profit. In most cases the companies rely on teachers for the names of students to contact.

It is the policy of the Alva Independent School District #001 that no information about or names of students be provided to any organization purporting to recognize student achievement unless that organization has had its background checked and is on the list of approved honoring organizations kept in the superintendent's office.
