

Financial and Transportation Policy  
for  
Out of State Competition

Any time any student(s) plan to enter competitions which could result in their competing out of the state of Oklahoma, the sponsor of the student activity shall obtain the approval of the Superintendent prior to the entry being submitted.

For out of state competition, the District financial support will be limited as follows:

A District car or suburban may be used without charge for trips of 600 miles (one way map mileage) or less. In cases where a bus is needed, the activity will be charged for the cost of the driver or may provide their own driver, approved by the district.

For trips longer than the above, District transportation will generally not be used. In what are considered "special cases" the Board may grant a request from the activity sponsor for the use of district vehicles.

District support for room, board and travel costs for out of state competition will be limited to a reimbursement of 50% of the actual cost to the student(s) not (not to exceed \$300) and 75% of the actual cost to the sponsor(s) (not to exceed \$400). Receipts of expenditures will be required.
