

Awards, Honors and Scholarships

American Legion Awards

The American Legion presents citizenship awards to two senior boys and two senior girls. They are elected by the Senior Class on the following basis:

Girl - character, courage, companionship, scholarship, and service;

Boy - honor, courage, leadership, scholarship, and service.

G. Omar Hill Football Award

G. Omar Hill Football Award is presented to the senior player who best exemplifies the qualities of leadership, value to the team, and scholarship. He is elected by the members of the football squad.

Masonic Lodge Awards

Each year the Masonic Lodge presents two "Student of Today" Awards. These awards are presented to the outstanding senior boy and the outstanding girl as chosen by the faculty.

National Honor Society

To be eligible, one must be ranked in the upper one-third of the Senior class scholastically. The teachers elect fifteen percent of the total enrollment to this honor society with the following factors in mind:

service, leadership, character, scholarship

Oklahoma Honor Society

Membership will be based upon work done during the first semester of the current year and the second semester of the preceding year. The standing of students enrolled in the first year of the high school will be based on the work done during the first semester of the current year. Ten percent of the high school enrollment will be eligible for membership.

Senior Class Honors

Seniors with a grade point average of 4.0 will graduate with Very Highest Honors. Seniors with a grade point average of 3.70 to 3.99 will graduate with Highest Honors. Seniors with a grade point average of 3.40 to 3.69 will graduate with High Honors. Seniors with a grade point average of 3.0 to 3.39 will graduate with Honors.

Northwestern Oklahoma State University awards scholarships for ACT scores. These ACT tests are to be taken during your senior year. An automatic scholarship will be given anyone with a 25 composite ACT score. Other scholarships will be given dependent on the ACT score and GPA of the student.
