The Cooperative Education Project is funded through contributions from several area school districts with the Alva District acting as the LEA (Local Education Authority).

In its capacity as LEA, the Alva District has the responsibility of monitoring expenditures and the services provided, setting the budget, staffing and finding housing for the unit.

Child-find (child identification and awareness)	Social work/counseling
Comprehensive system of personnel development inservice	
Psychometric/Psychologist services for school age children
